HCBS Specialized Medical Care

Specialized Medical Care allows one nurse to provide Specialized Medical Care to two participants, related or unrelated and living in the same home, as long as both participants are served by the same Managed Care Organization (MCO). If more than one recipient resides in the same home and the level of care needs cannot be met by a personal care attendant, the MCO must meet the level of need with appropriate staffing.

In instances where a nurse is providing Specialized Medical Care to two participants, the MCO will document the following:

Shared T1000 services must:

- Be clinically justified through individual assessments for each member.
- Be authorized individually for each member.
- Clearly identify in the Person-Centered service plan.

EVV Requirements:

- The Registered Nurse (RN) or Licensed Practice Nurse (LPN) must clock in/out in AuthentiCare under one member at a time.
- Ensure total logged time does not exceed authorized combined hours.
- Providers must maintain internal tracking to ensure Electronic Visit Verification (EVV) records at the Electronic Health Record align.
