

Waivers for Intermediate Care Facility Level of Care Developmental Disabilities (DD) Waivers

This section pertains to the Family Support Waiver (FSW), DD Adult Day (DDAD) Waiver, and the Comprehensive DD (CDD) Waiver.

Definitions

Relative is any person related to the participant by blood or marriage to the third degree of consanguinity, including a foster parent, foster child, stepparent, stepchild, and adopted children and their adoptive parents. In the case of an Indian child, relative is defined in Neb. Rev. Stat. § 43-1503.

Legal Guardian is a person appointed by a court to serve as a guardian. Legal Guardians may only serve as agency providers.

Legally Responsible Individual (LRI) is a spouse or the natural or adoptive parents of minor children.
