Vermont Medicaid Provider Revalidation

Policy Summary:

Vermont is committed to safeguarding the integrity of the Medicaid program. The Medicaid program proactively implements program integrity efforts to identify and address fraud waste and abuse while ensuring oversight of the Medicaid program and enrolled providers.

In response to a request from the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS), Vermont Medicaid is conducting an off-cycle revalidation of providers identified as high-risk and select providers identified as moderate risk. This off-cycle provider revalidation is a component of [Vermont Medicaid's two-year provider revalidation strategy](#) submitted to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS).

Vermont's strategy includes the following actions:

- Off-cycle revalidations of High-Risk providers.
- Off-cycle revalidations of select Moderate Risk providers.
- Comprehensive review of Vermont's provider type risk level designations.
- Comprehensive review of risk level designations for enrolled providers with no National Provider Identifier (NPI).
- Evaluation of revalidation schedule for specific provider types.
- Evaluation of potential provider enrollment moratoria.

A swift off-cycle revalidation of High-Risk providers will begin July 1, 2026.

Provider types identified as High-Risk include:

1. The following provider types for five years following initial enrollment or upon a change in ownership.
 - Nursing facilities
 - Home health agencies
 - Hospice providers
 - Durable medical equipment/prosthetic, orthotic, supplies (DMEPOS) vendors

2. Providers (of any type) who have been designated as High Risk due to credible allegations of fraud, waste or abuse in the Medicaid program.

The off-cycle revalidation of High-Risk Providers will be followed by revalidation of select provider types identified as Moderate Risk.

Approximately 300 enrolled providers will be subject to this off-cycle revalidation. Impacted providers will be notified by Gainwell Technologies,

These efforts are intended to verify ongoing compliance with Medicaid enrollment requirements and reinforce program integrity.

Effective Date:

June 4, 2026

Authority/Legal Basis:

Federal regulations at 42 CFR § 455.414 require state Medicaid agencies to revalidate enrolled providers at least every five years and to conduct additional screening activities for providers designated as high risk. The state may conduct off-cycle revalidation as needed to protect the integrity of the Medicaid program.
